Transportation: Georgina

Dial-a-Ride (DAR) north will be operating during our sessions and is a transportation option (last pick up is 8pm) for those who do not live in walking distance to public transit. <http://www.yorkregiontransit.com/en/schedulesmaps/DAR-North.asp>

DAR North will pick your clients up at their curbed address and bring them to the closest bus stop. Rides can be booked 60 minutes in advance, and up to 7 days in advance. The cost is a YRT/Viva transit fare. Customers can transfer DAR North to/from conventional YRT/Viva buses. The vehicles are fully accessible and are available for all in Georgina and East Gwillimbury.
